### Great solutions for photos in albums as well as delicate originals

If photos have been in an album for a long time, they may be glued in or covered with plastic protectors. In either case, damage can occur when trying to remove them. With the optional **Kodak** Photo Selector Accessory, multiple photos on each album page can be scanned on a **Kodak** Flatbed Accessory, and then saved as individual image files. So there's no risk of harm to them and album pages remain intact.

There are two choices for optional flatbeds: the **Kodak** Legal Size Flatbed Accessory and the **Kodak** A3 Size Flatbed Accessory. These are also handy for scanning larger documents and bound pages with the book edge feature.
